

Visitation Guidelines

Effective November 17, 2021 the following process will be implemented with respect to visitation with residents of Bishop's Commons.

- Families will no longer need to schedule a visit with your loved one. You may come at any time on any day of the week to visit and stay as long as you'd like.
- To ensure that we continue to provide a safe environment for our residents during this pandemic, staff and those visiting while adhering to government guidelines, we will continue with required safety protocols.
- Everyone entering our residence will continue to sign-in attesting that you have no signs or symptoms of illness, have not been exposed to COVID and have a temperature check.
- Everyone is required to wear a face mask in common areas and encouraged to wear a face mask in the presence of their loved one.
- Visits should be held in your loved one's room and you are discouraged from walking the halls or visiting with other residents outside your own loved one's room.
- We also ask that you refrain from visiting during meal times as we cannot ensure safe social distancing in the dining room.
- Our front doors will be unlocked from 8:30am – 8:30pm as they were prior to the Covid-19 pandemic.
