



Effective September 9, 2020 the following process will be implemented with respect to visitation from family and friends with the residents of St. Francis Commons and Bishop's Commons.

1. Visitation will be permitted outdoors only in the designated areas Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 1:00pm-3:00pm.
2. Visitation will be limited to 5 families per day or 10% of the current census. There will only be two family members permitted per resident who must be masked at all times. Any visitor under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. Family must contact St. Francis Commons prior to visitation to reserve their spot. Visitation reservations will be on a first come first serve basis.
4. There will be a staff person present at the entry point to screen each family member for temperature, sanitizing hands and ensuring they all have a mask and maintain a six foot social distance from residents at all times. They will also be required to sign the visitor screening tool.
**If a family member refuses to wear a mask, they are not permitted into the visitation area.
5. There will be ground markers placed designating 6 foot distances between residents and family members. Furniture is not to be moved and family will be required to maintain the six foot distance at all times.
6. At the conclusion of each visitation day, all benches and chairs will be sanitized to prepare for the next day's visitation.
7. All visitation is outdoors and is weather pending. It can be cancelled or revoked for extreme heat, inclement weather or non-compliance related to this policy.

All above terms are subject to change based on testing results of staff and residents (if necessary).
